Greetings from sunny Scotland. The weather has been relatively good so far and I am enjoying walking in the hills behind my parents' house, which is refreshing as well as good exercise.

## Japan/OMF News

Thank you for praying for the church AGM. My placement is now confirmed to Sakata Lutheran Brethren Church in the town of Sakata on the west coast of Yamagata Prefecture. The church is led by Pastor Kizu (Kee-zoo), who is from the Greater Tokyo Area but felt a burden to serve in rural Japan. David and I attended the same church as him and his wife, Tamae (Ta-ma-e), in Ichikawa from 2013-16 before he went to Bible college. They have four young daughters.

Sakata has a population of about 96,000 people but according to Pastor Kizu, only 6 small churches with a total of about 180 members. His church has around 50 people, with most being in their late 60s, 70s and 80s. Pastor Kizu has a real desire to reach out to the community in Sakata and the surrounding areas and asked OMF for help. I have a call with him in February to talk through some more details but for now am looking forward to all that the Lord has planned for me there.

I was able to finish most of my work on the international project I was helping with, though I have now been asked to consider another thing to help with at the international level. Please pray for:

- God to go before all the arrangements to serve with Sakata Church and a helpful call with Pastor Kizu on the 18th.
- Wisdom as to what things to say "yes" to when I get different requests.

# Home Assignment

January was a bit of a crazy month, with a lot of meetings and preparation to be done, but I was really encouraged by the people I met at each, and especially to hear folks praying for Japan. February is a little quieter, so I would like to get started on a couple of projects I would like to do during my Home Assignment, including starting to learn Biblical Greek, which I hope will help me in explaining the Bible in Japanese.
