OMF News

Our field welcome group meets on the 1st to decide on some more candidates. It is encouraging to see so many applying to serve in Japan, though it does create capacity issues for our language study programme. We are working on a prayer website which will follow the themes of the Beneath the Surface prayer booklet. Sarah Chang from Pioneers and I meet on the 4th to try to finalise the content. We hope it will all be ready by the end of the year. In the meantime, a Norwegian translation of the booklet has been finalized and 20,000 copies printed.

Last month I visited a church which is a possible placement for my next term. The visit went well and the next stage is for the church deacons to have a discussion on the 13th. We are still waiting for confirmation of who will take over my current role. In the meantime, I am preparing to pass different responsibilities to various people who have agreed to help out until someone is in place.

The Field Leadership Team meets online on the **18**th to approve next year's budget. In one form or another, I served on the team since 2010 and this will be my last meeting. From **24-30**th I travel to Singapore for Global Vision Council meetings, OMF's highest board of governance. We meet in person once a year, and this time there is a lot to discuss. Please pray for:

- More teachers for our new missionaries;
