We have now entered typhoon season in Japan. A particularly strong typhoon hit the west of Japan earlier this week and is now making its way slowly up the country dropping record amounts of rain as it does, causing flooding and landslides in various places, killing some people and injuring others. September is looking like a rather busy month. We are now waiting for final confirmation of the person to take over my role from next year. Plans for an interim solution are starting to fall into place but there is still a lot to arrange. I will probably now continue fully in my role until the end of October, rather than the end of September as had been planned. In the meantime, I am having meetings with all those who serve in my Sector to hear their thoughts too. **Prue Tan** unfortunately became ill so was not able to come to Ichikawa for TCK (Third Culture Kid) orientation, so I will now travel to Sapporo from **9-12**th to do that, plus have some other meetings with different members. Field Welcome Group meets on the **4**th as we consider new candidates applying to come to Japan. I will also do an orientation for new members on funerals in Japan on the **30**th.

The decision on my placement from next summer after my Home Assignment might be finalized this month. The Sector Leader will travel to the church on the **7-8**th. If that goes well, I will visit on the **21-24**th to attend a church service, meet church leadership, and explore the area a bit.

Some of you will remember **Kaori Chua** and her husband, How Chuang. We came to Japan at the same time in 1998 and worked together for four years starting Hiragishi Izumi Church in Sapporo. How Chuang died from cancer in 2015. Kaori is now getting married to Peter Leong, a Singaporean from New Zealand, on the 7^{th} . He is moving to Japan to be with her and her 12-year daughter, Airi. It will be a privilege to attend the wedding. Please pray for:

- The ongoing process of appointing my successor and planning for the interim solution;
- Good listening in all the conversations and meetings I have, including on the trip to Sapporo;
- The Lord's confirmation as to the location of my next placement; and
- ➡ The Lord's blessing on Kaori, Peter and Airi as they make huge adjustments in their lives.
