Team	Commitment	Additional Details
AV Team (St. Michael's)	Rota – currently every 6 weeks	More volunteers needed for camera and laptop/screen operation as part of the projection team for Sunday morning services. Training and support given. You don't need to be a technical or computer genius. However, great opportunity for young people looking for experience.
Boys Brigade	20:00 – 21:30 on Thursdays in Cross House. Either every week or on a 2/3/4 week rotation (they are flexible).	Volunteers need to complete a disclosure, a safeguarding course and 3 online modules which would take approximately 30 mins each.
Coffee mornings (Torphichen)	Monthly	2 roles: • Organisation and co-ordination of monthly coffee mornings at Torphichen • Helpers
Events team	Various roles, ad hoc help	You would only help with tasks you feel comfortable with and when you are available. These include welcoming people at the door; setting up and taking down the stage; helping with the sound and cameras; and generally helping to make the event a success.

Open Church Stewards (St. Michael's)	Flexible rota	Looking for additional stewards so that the church can be open for visitors as much as possible. New people will always be paired up with an experienced person.

Property Team	As required. Attend monthly 90 minute Property Team meeting.	The Property Coordinator is responsible for identifying and managing issues with the buildings, with the support of the experienced Property Team – no DIY skills necessary!
